### New Student Orientation 2022

#### Vaccination, Arrival and Transportation Arrangements

##### Vaccination and Arrival Arrangements

All students must have received three doses of COVID-19 vaccine as recognised by the HKSAR Government to fulfil the University's vaccination requirement. Those unable to do so will be required to produce a medical certificate as proof of being unfit for vaccination, report their medical exemption certificate information and produce a negative test result issued three days prior to the date of campus entry.

##### Before Arrival

1. Please upload your photo to [EdU Card Photo Upload System](#) for student card production.
2. Once you have completed the EdU Card Registration and upload a photo, you are required to submit your vaccination, testing records, and/or infection information via [the University's VTR online system](#) for campus access before collecting your EdU Card. 3. You **SHOULD NOT RETURN** to campus for participation in the New Student Orientation if you encounter one of the following situations:
  - if you are tested positive for COVID-19;
  - if you have any symptoms of COVID-19;
  - if you are residing in specified premises for compulsory testing;
  - if you are the close contact of any person infected with COVID-19; or
  - if you are observing isolation or quarantine order that issued from The Department of Health.

Please promptly seek medical attention as necessary.

##### On-Arrival to Campus

4. For your *first-time* access to the campus, all students are required:
  - a. To use the "LeaveHomeSafe" mobile App and scan the venue QR code of the campus\*;
  - b. To check the body temperature at the entrance security post;
  - c. To register at the campus entrance; and
  - d. To show your offer letter/email to the security.

*\*Only those with a "Vaccinated/Exempted" QR code (blue) will be allowed to enter the campus.*

5. Please collect your student card at C-LP-20 as soon as you receive OCIO's notification. For subsequent access to the campus, you must tap your student card over the card reader at the campus entrance. A green "VALID" sign, as below, should be shown on [the University's VTR online system](#) which denotes that you have fulfilled the University's vaccination requirements:

## Transportation Arrangements

### *Going to Campus*

1. [University Station Shuttle Bus Services](#) (departing from [MTR University Station](#)): The bus operates at 5 to 10-minute intervals and will take you around 15 – 20 minutes to get to the EdUHK. Bus fare is HK\$5.00 per trip, payable by Octopus Cards. Please allow sufficient waiting and travelling time.
2. [KMB 74K \(departing from MTR Tai Po Market Station\)](#): The bus operates at 15 to 20-minute intervals, and will take you around 20 – 25 minutes to get to the EdUHK. Bus fare is HK\$5.20 per trip. Please reserve sufficient waiting and travelling time.
3. [Green Minibus No. 26 \(from Bayshore Towers, Ma On Shan Station\)](#): The minibus operates at 6 to 9-minute intervals. Minibus fare is HK\$13.80, section fares are offered.

### *Departing from Campus*

As students and other campus users may be leaving the campus at the same time or during the rush hours, waiting time for shuttle bus and public transportations will take longer than usual.

1. [University Station Shuttle Bus Services](#) (departing from [the Entrance Plaza](#)): The bus operates at 5 to 10-minute intervals and will take you around 15 – 20 minutes to get to the MTR University Station. Bus fare is HK\$5.00 per trip, payable by Octopus Cards. Please tap your student card on the card reader when boarding to verify your student status.
2. [KMB 74K \(from Sam Mun Tsai\)](#): The bus operates at 15 to 20-minute intervals. Bus fare is HK\$5.20 per trip.
3. [Green Minibus No. 26 \(from EdUHK\)](#): The minibus operates at 9-minute intervals. Minibus fare is HK\$13.80, section fares are offered.
